Topic or focus of the activity:  Gina and Karin work with NoBeep (Northern Ontario Black Empowerment Program). Connection to the curriculum and/or purpose of the activity: This session helps students connect what they are learning in school to real-life experiences and supports in the community. It gives students practical information about scholarships, bursaries, and events they can get involved in, while also helping them build confidence and resilience. By talking openly about racism and ways to cope or respond, the session supports student well-being, inclusion, and personal growth, and encourages students to feel supported and empowered both in and out of school.
